MEETING BETWEEN INVESTPENANG AND THE COMMITTEE

3. The Meeting between InvestPenang and the Committee of Frepenca was held virtually on 5 April 2021. The Meeting was chaired by Dato' Seri Lee Kah Choon and joined virtually by Dato' Loo Lee Lian, CEO of InvestPenang and also all the Committee Members.
